## School Aims

The School will aim to:

- ❖ Ensure that all children are safe and happy in the school environment.
- ❖ Plan learning opportunities that meet the individual needs of all children
- ❖ Keep parents/carers informed about the progress of their child. This will include sending home an annual progress report in the Summer Term. Parent consultations will also be held during which progress will be discussed and where parents/carers can tell us about their child.
- ❖ Set appropriate homework and provide feedback. In EYFS, this will generally be reading and reading activities.
- ❖ Provide opportunities every day for parents and carers to be able to speak to a member of staff.
- ❖ Contact parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or personal belongings.
- ❖ Let parents/carers know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's health, work or behaviour.
- ❖ Keep parents/carers informed about school activities through a weekly newsletter and the school website.

## Parents/Carers Aims

I/We will aim to:

❖ Ensure an adult accompanies my child to and from school, sees them into class and collects them at the end of the session. Inform the school about any changes to arrangements for bringing or collecting my child.

❖ See that my child goes to school regularly, on time, properly equipped and dressed in named uniform. Inform the school before 9.30 am if my child is to be absent, giving reasons for the absence.

❖ Avoid holidays in term time.

❖ Let the school know about any issues, concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour, e.g. parental separation, illness within the family or bereavement.

❖ Support the School's Behaviour and Anti-Bullying Policy.

❖ Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning. I will aim to read at least four times a week with my child at home.

❖ Get to know about my child's life at school e.g. by reading the weekly newsletter, attending consultations and reading the school website.

❖ Be respectful and considerate towards members of the school and local community e.g. speaking calmly to us, parking and driving responsibly and respecting our neighbours' property.

❖ Speak to school staff about any concerns. No adverse comments about children, staff or the school should be posted on social network sites including Facebook.

❖ Keep the school up-to-date with contact details, including mobile phone numbers.
